


COVID-19 VISITOR GUIDANCE

Protect Yourself and Your Loved Ones From COVID-19

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer that contains at least 62% alcohol.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- You must wear a face mask or face covering in public when social distancing is not possible.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Remember to maintain social distancing precautions of at least 6 feet.

Visitor Guidance / Protocol

- Visitors must sign in and will be screened for exposure to and signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to the visit, including a temperature check.
- Visitors must wear the provided disposable face mask.
- Hand sanitizer will be used before and after the visit and as needed.
- On-site visits will be scheduled, no more than 2 visitors at a time per visit.
- All Visitors must provide their: name, physical address, phone numbers, email.
- If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
- Visitation will be prohibited for a period of twenty-eight (28) days, if any of the following occur:
 - If at any time during the State of Emergency the region falls below Phase III;
 - If at any time there is an identified presumptive or positive COVID-19 Resident;
 - If at any time there is a staff member identified as presumptive or positive COVID-19 via PCR test result;
 - The Facility fails to maintain full compliance with all state and federal requirements, state Executive Orders state reporting requirements including COVID-19 focus surveys, HERDS and staff testing surveys, and federally required submission of COVID-19 data to the NHSN.
